We Kceans are fortunate to have a first rate sports infrastructure in the school and a rich calendar of sports activities. We have 4 Houses in the school and all Inter House competitions in major games and athletic events are fought fiercely for top honours.

This year, the finals in all games were played with great zeal and vigour by both boys and girls under Senior and Junior categories. The major sporting events were Swimming, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Hand Ball and Table Tennis. Poonch House made a clean sweep of Championship Trophies in Swimming, Basketball, Football, Cricket, Hand Ball and Athletics. The Championship Trophies in Volleyball and Table Tennis went to Jammu House. Poonch House emerged the best House in sports followed by Jammu, Kashmir and Ladakh in the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> positions respectively.

It gives me great pleasure to inform you that KC Public School launched the Inaugural Shakuntala Rani Memorial Inter School Basketball tournament this year. This year, it was organized for girls only. From next year with the construction of new Basketball courts, boys' teams will also participate in the tournament. 6 teams from CBSE affiliated schools in Jammu & Akhnoor participated in the inaugural edition. The hosts KC Public School won the running Trophy after defeating MHACS Nagbani in a well fought final.

You might have noticed that a new Squash Court in under construction this year next to our Swimming Pool and our Tennis Court is being re-done to lay the synthetic surface. It will be one of the finest Tennis courts in Jammu region matching international standards.

Coming to our participation in sporting events at the State, National and International levels, I am pleased to inform you that after winning 12 Silver and 14 Bronze medals at the regional level Swimming Meet of the CBSE held at Delhi, 5 of our swimmers, namely, I, Rudraksh Gupta as Team Captain, Harkirat Singh, Ashiv Choudhary, Kinshuk Safaya and Gunjan Kokiloo went on to represent North Zone of the CBSE at the National level Meet held at Bhopal in November this year. 11 of us represented the State of J&K at the National level swimming Meet held at Goa in November.
